

LtCol William Henry Fulton, Jr.. USAF, Ret

Bill, age 83, passed away peacefully on June 29, 2015 at his home in Miromar Lakes, FL.

He is survived by his wife Thelma, the love of his life for 55 years. Three Children; Kym, Tracey and Billy, and Four grandchildren; Parker See, Nicole, John and Will.

Bill was born in Albany, NY on July 29, 1931, only child of William and Blanche Fulton, Sr., Troy, NY. Graduated from Lansingburgh High School '48, Troy, NY., completed his undergraduate studies at Union College. He was the first graduate of UNION ROTC USAF, later on earning his Masters in Industrial Engineering from Texas Tech, Lubbock, TX.

Among many honors bestowed, he earned The Distinguished Flying Cross and Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry. As a Pilot he was awarded 17 other Air Metals that recognized his "courage and outstanding airmanship" during numerous combat missions flown and commanded by him in Korea and Vietnam

He retired from the Air Force in 1974. Not acclimating to this Sedentary Life style he took a Job with Booz Allen and Hamilton as a Naval Consultant on the F-14 Project moving his Family to Isfahan, Iran in 1976. Picking up and moving was a way of life for Bill. He met and married his Wife Thelma while stationed in England, they wed in 1959. Together their travels took them from England to Reese AFB, Wright Patterson AFB, the Pentagon, and Ramstein AFB, with post retirement destinations in Virginia, Delaware and Florida. After returning from Iran, Bill made his career in Commercial Real Estate with EROLS, Burger King, Ponderosa and Friendly's, finishing his commercial Real Estate career bedside with Chambridge, Sterling, VA.

His Burial will held at a later date with Full Military Honors at Arlington National Cemetery.
